Antonio & Diana had planned to take their next furlough this year and be in the US from April through mid-October. However, during Antonio's USA visa renewal process, “to our dismay ...heartbreak”, he was given a date of March of 2022 for his appointment! This means Antonio cannot enter the USA this year and their furlough will not be until 2022. Also, Diana's USA passport runs out in October 2021, so she will need to be in the USA within the next six months to renew it. -The plan is for her to travel to Michigan in May. She will host in person an open house at First Baptist Church of Holland, Michigan, our sending church.
